Heritage Customers:

As the days come and go, deadlines are here and gone, but we are happy to announce we will start receiving grain at the Heritage Cooperative – Marysville Ag Campus and Research Farm on Monday, January 18, 2016. On September 29, 2015, we started digging the boot pits at the site and, yes we are ready to receive grain. Over the next few days we will be unloading a few test loads while continuing to work on the automation and other issues that need finalized. In order to monitor and load the bins evenly (which is required by the engineers), we will be running only one pit for a short term. To say that everything will go as planned, with no delays, would only be kidding us and you as customers. As we diligently work to get both pits on-line, there may be some issues which will need addressed going forward.

We ask that everyone be patient, courteous to our employees, and please be cautious as we still have contractors on site working around the silos and other areas of the campus. Safety is top priority to Heritage Cooperative!

At this time, there are no “entrance” signs from Scottslawn Road, but we are easy to find and access. From Industrial Parkway, the entrance is approximately eight-tenths of a mile on the right side of the road. From State Route 736, we are approximately 1.2 miles on the left side of the road. We have approximately 1500 feet of driveway, wide enough for at least three lines of trucks. This equates to 25-30 trucks per line that could be staged prior to the probe, not to mention the numbers we can stage after the probe and prior to the pits. “PLEASE” do not park on Scottslawn Road. We would hope we do not get to that point. So, we cannot stress enough “do not park on Scottslawn Road”.

As you approach the scale office, you will notice we will probe trucks prior to the scales. There is a red/green light for your convenience to know when it’s time for you to move from the probe area. If you are not sure when to move, it’s always best to wait as an employee will wave you forward. Once you get on the scales, you will give the Heritage employee at the window the name and selling information for the load you are hauling. You will then receive paperwork which includes the gross weight, grade and selling information. If you question the grade, you have the right to circle back around the building and take your place in line for a re-grade. When you arrive at the pit, an employee will put a number on the paperwork and you will give this back to the person weighing you out. This process may seem like a lot, but once we get the flow going, the wait time will be minimal and the results will be worthy.

Scottslawn Road Grain Entrance:

Follow the yellow line towards the scale office and you will notice that we will probe trucks prior to the scales. There is a red/green light for your convenience to know when it's time for you to move from the probe area. Once you get on the scales, you will give the Heritage employee at the window the name and selling information for the load you are hauling. You will then receive paperwork which includes the gross weight, grade and selling information. When you arrive at the pit, an employee will put a number on the paperwork and you will give this back to the person weighing you out. When leaving the dump to the outbound scale and the exit please follow the blue line.
